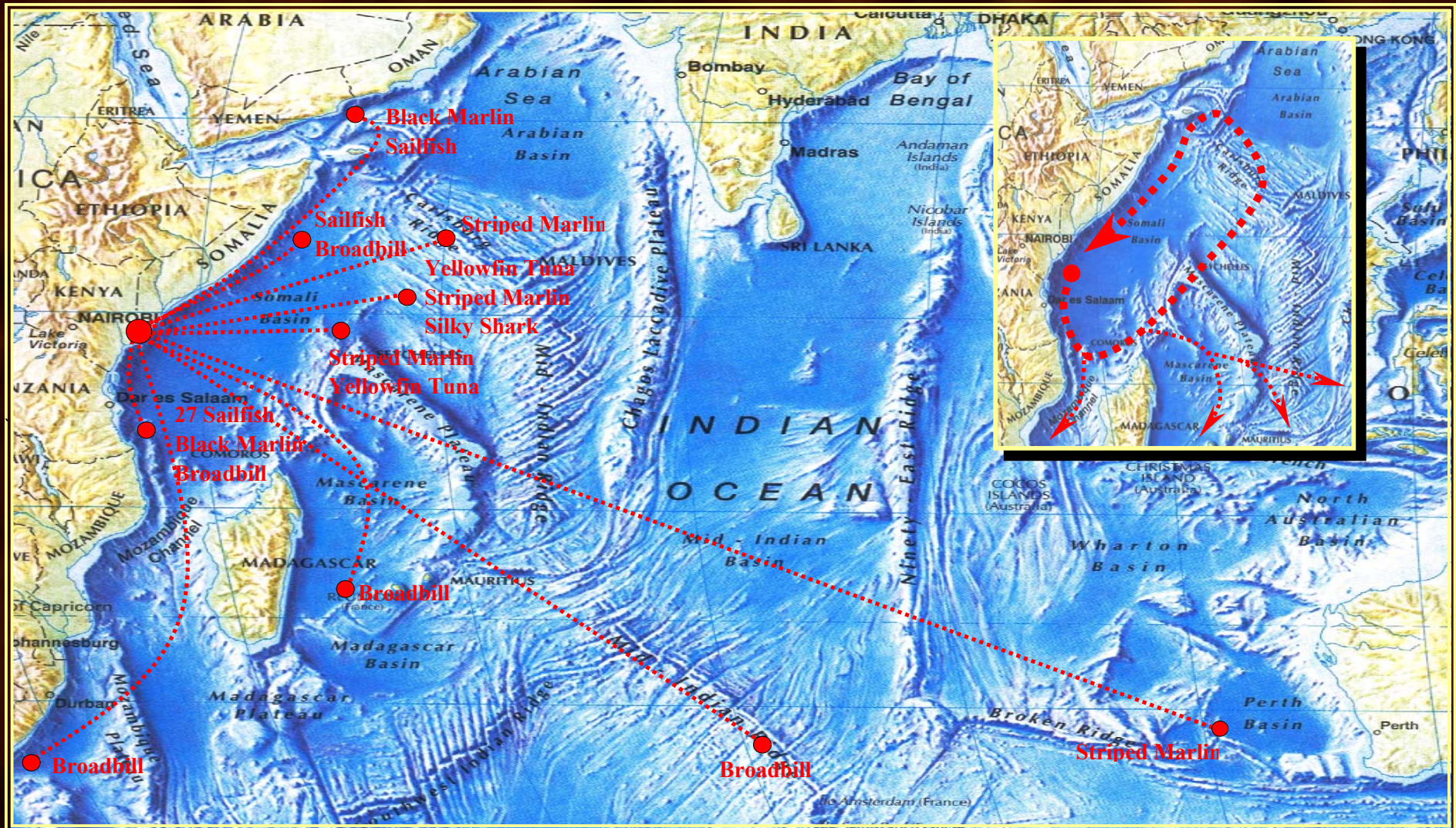


INTERNATIONAL RECOVERIES OF INTEREST



Above are some of the most exciting international recoveries; among others you can see the striped marlin tagged on the Rips and re-caught off Perth, Australia travelling 5250 miles in just 195 days or the broadbill tagged on the NKB and re-caught on the Mid Indian Ridge travelling 3600 miles, another Broadbill tagged off the NKB was re-caught off Port Elizabeth, South Africa after 1 year 6 days, travelling 2400 miles and a Black Marlin tagged off Watamu and re-caught off Yemen travelling 1880 miles in 159 days.

The vast majority of over 500 reported re-captures are within Kenyan waters, times out range from 8 years to just a few days. Nearly all recoveries are confined to the Somali basin and its surrounding ridges and plateaus as seen on the inserted map.
